Kindergarten children will finish at 2.30pm for two weeks then they will finish at 2.55pm, along with all other students, from Monday 17 Feb. Please remember our school day starts at 8.55am and punctuality is very much appreciated. Playground supervision starts at 8.30am so no children are to arrive before this time, please.

A number of maintenance and repair jobs were completed here during the holidays but the large shelter for K-2 children to assemble under was not built, as planned. I am quite disappointed but I hope to see it erected in the next few weeks. It is often very warm when we return to school so this is a timely reminder that we have a No hat, No play policy at our school.
